DEADLINE: February 28, 2017 — applications must be received by the stated deadline.

Why apply to the Certificate Program?

- Completion of the Certificate Program provides you with knowledge, credentials, and access as an alumnus to a lifelong community of practitioners dedicated to the medium of photography.
- PCNW is located in the Capitol Hill neighborhood of Seattle, with easy access to galleries and museums here, as well as in Pioneer Square, downtown, and the U-District. Our facilities include wet darkrooms, two digital labs, three lighting studios, an alternative process studio and an exhibition space featuring five-six shows a year and a broad range of significant photography.
- Program attendees are immersed in the history, theory and practice of creating photographic work, and are taught by engaged professionals from within and beyond our region. Masterclasses by visiting artists complement ten-week courses focused on technical and creative knowledge specific to this craft.
- With evening courses and small classes of not more than twelve people, the Certificate Program is personal, flexible and accessible. Most participants complete the course of study in 3-5 years, with the final year being dedicated to a thesis project. Estimated cost to complete the program is approximately \$19,900, including materials and lab fees (tuition is charged on a per class, per quarter basis).

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS | In order for a Certificate Program application to be considered, and for a student to be accepted into the program, the student must provide Photo Center NW with one of the following:

- Transcripts from Undergraduate or Graduate studies,
- Proof of High School Diploma or GED,
OR
- Evidence of successful completion of two years of courses at an accredited college or equivalent credentials from a foreign educational institution

PORTFOLIO | Please submit a selection of 10-15 images, including 5 images from a single body or collection of work. Images may be submitted as a physical portfolio or on a CD. For CD submissions, please name your files according to the following convention: Last Name, First Name_Title (example: Smith, John_Sunset). Portfolios will not be returned. Applicants are welcome to include an artist statement or other information you would like to share about your portfolio.
